3:30PM- Orchestra sound check

4:00PM- Trailers dropped at LJ

4:15PM- Wind ensemble (4th period) call time

4:30PM- Wind ensemble (4th period) sound check

4:30PM- Marching band and guard call time- percussion sets up- brass to balcony

5:00PM- Marching band sound check

5:30PM- Jazz band call time (for students only in jazz)

6:00PM- Jazz band sound check

6:30PM- Rehearsal ends, doors open for audience

6:50PM- Jazz band on-stage, everyone else seated in balcony

7:00PM- Concert begins!

9:00PM- Concert ends, everyone racks their own chair and stand, brass on clean up, load trailers

9:30PM- Clean up ends, dismissed to go home

Notes:

- We will have a taco truck outside LJ so you can get dinner from the taco truck when you are not in rehearsal. Bring money so you can eat.
- Wind ensemble (4th period) students need to wear their concert blacks.
- If you are not in wind ensemble, you need your full uniform (no shakos.)
- Guard will need their uniforms, including hair and make up and shoes.
- Be on your best behavior for the entire afternoon/evening. Be focused and diligent, listen to instructions given to you by staff, boosters, section leaders, etc. Be respectful.
- Brass must stay after the concert to help with clean up, including moving percussion equipment to the trailers, racking chairs and stands, helping boosters take down decorations, cleaning up backstage, cleaning up trash from the audience, etc. All marching brass must get loaded on the trailers following the concert (sousas, mellophones, marching baritones/euphoniums.) This will take approximately 30 minutes. Everyone needs to help, do not stand around.
- Percussion must stay after the concert to help load the trailers.
- Woodwinds are dismissed as soon as the concert is over (please rack your chairs and stands.) Woodwinds will be on clean up duty for the next concert.
- Remember that this is your final exam for band this semester. Points will be deducted from your final exam grade for tardies, not having appropriate equipment, not helping with clean up/loading, talking, etc.
